### **DESCRIPTION**

Ultipatch Linemaster is a durable, quick drying paint for use with stencils, line marking equipment or for free hand applications.

Ultipatch Linemaster can be used on car parks, within factories, for road marking, highway maintenance, tennis courts and any other sports surfaces, playgrounds, warehouse layouts, hazard warnings, surveying and surfaces identification of underground services.

# **PREPARATION**

All application substrates must be sound, clean and free from dust, dirt, debris, oil, grease and other contaminants.

### **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Shake can vigorously until the agitator ball rattles and then shake for a further 1-2 minutes. Invert the aerosol and fasten into the adapter. The can may also be hand held.

If the nozzle becomes blocked during use, remove aerosol from applicator, stand upright and repeatedly depress nozzle until it clears.

Ultipatch Linemaster dries in approximately 30 minutes where it can withstand light traffic. The paint is fully curing in 24 hours.

# **CLEAN UP**

Paint spillages should be cleaned up as soon as possible. Cleaning of tools and equipment should be carried out as soon as is practicable well away from the application area.

All Pozament products are factory blended, tested and packaged to quality control procedures in accordance with BS EN ISO 9001.

### PACKAGING AND STORAGE

Ultipatch Linemaster is available in boxes of 12  $\times$  750ml cans. Ultipatch Linemaster should be stored in cool, dry, frost free areas out of direct sunlight. The product should be used on a first in – first out basis.

Shelf life is 12 months' subject to temperature and humidity. Individual cans should be stored in sealed original packaging in a dry location at temperatures between 5°C and 500°C. Avoid exposure to water, frost or heat - high temperatures and high humidity will lead to a reduced shelf life.
